**Innovative Solutions Award Winners Announced at the
2009 Healthvision Annual User Conference**

DALLAS – October 12, 2009 – Healthvision, a leading provider of healthcare specific software and solutions, proudly announced the winners of their prestigious Innovative Solutions Award during their Annual User Conference held at the Marriott DFW Airport in Dallas, Texas on October 5-7, 2009.

The purpose of the Innovative Solutions Award is to recognize organizations that creatively implement Healthvision products and solutions to meet specific needs of their organization. Healthvision selected three winners this year:

Caris Dx

Caris Dx is a U.S.-based biosciences company specializing in the development and commercialization of clinically-validated molecular diagnostics and anatomic pathology services primarily in the fields of oncology, dermatopathology, hematopathology and gastrointestinal pathology.

Using Cloverleaf and Secure Courier (CSC), Caris Dx developed a solution for printing from their web-based application to local printers.

Their web-based application converts PDFs representing requisitions and/or labels into postscript format and then pushes them to their CSC server over a TCP/IP connection. The CSC client then uses separate processes called “pconnects” to pull the label and the requisition. The pconnect pulls the postscript file across and passes it to ghostscript for printing.

Security issues were also addressed directly through CSC. The postscript files are encrypted using AES256 encryption and a header is placed on those files so that they are routed to the appropriate receiving system. This header also tells the receiving system whether the content is a label or a requisition because they have to be routed to different printers.

They currently have 60 clients configured with this solution and new clients can implement this functionality within minutes.

Florida Hospital

Florida Hospital is the largest private not-for-profit hospital in Central Florida, with 2,188 licensed beds on 7 campuses functioning as a single hospital, and has a daily message volume of 1.2 million. It has a complex and well-organized integration environment with Cloverleaf providing the hub that links a plethora of diverse systems contributing to all aspects of patient care.

Florida Hospital has used Cloverleaf in numerous ways to meet the ongoing needs of their organization such as:

1. Platform Migration - In the course of developing the migration strategy from AIX to a virtualized Linux platform concurrent with their Cloverleaf upgrade from 5.1 to 5.5, the Integration Team retooled their testing methodology concept, using Cloverleaf to create a Production Simulation Module (PSM), a comprehensive tool that would evaluate functionality, capacity, scalability, and sustainability using actual production data and metrics.
2. Interface Strategy - In order to support a phased rollout strategy for the Cerner Millennium implementation, the Integration Team designed a plan that effectively created a “shadow” configuration in its Cloverleaf production environment, allowing a smooth transition to new interfaces as well as uninterrupted connectivity to systems not yet migrated, plus retaining prior configuration availability in the event of backout.

Using Cloverleaf, the Integration Team has been able to provide solutions which have:

- improved patient safety and clinician satisfaction.
- bridged functional gaps between different systems.
- effected seamless patient movement in systems deployed independently at multiple campuses of a single-hospital environment.
- preserved real-time availability of patient demographics in third-party systems challenged to accept high volume message traffic.

Central DuPage Hospital

Central DuPage Hospital (CDH) is a nationally recognized 313-bed facility located in Winfield, Ill., a suburb west of Chicago. CDH is a leading center for medical technology and one of the busiest surgical centers in Illinois.

CDH developed an interface for automated lab results, offering their patients 24/7 access to lab results for certain tests. This was accomplished by sending lab results from Co path into Cloverleaf and, based on a set of rules after reviewing the information found the OBX segments, the custom interface would either allow the record to continue or drop in the engine.

If the lab result is satisfactory based on the seven scan rules setup in the interface, the

message is converted from a HL7 message into a VRL message. Then it is sent via FTP in the time base thread every 30 minutes into their dataset hosted at Televox.
